**WHO'S BREAKING GROUND: Burkentine Builders.** The Hanover-based construction company held a chilly groundbreaking this week for Terraces at Maplewood, a rental community near the Susquehanna Union Green mixed-use development in suburban Harrisburg (pictured below).

- Burkentine's \$64 million project will bring 90 garden apartments and 146 townhomes to Susquehanna Township.
- The first phase of the three-phase project is expected to be completed in August

**The bottom line:** Multifamily construction nationwide could reach its highest levels this year since the 1980s, according to a forecast by the [National Apartment Association](#).
